One of the Euro-MPs who stood for UKIP last time in this region (Tom Wise) is now on trial for fraud; another UKIP MEP, Ashley Mote, has already been found guilty of fraud and imprisoned. A vote for the Green Party is a vote for openness & integrity.

Greens *double* support in new poll - Greens gaining on UKIP and LibDems

A recent poll in the Independent on Sunday has shown the Green Party as having doubled their usual support from 6% to 12%. Another poll showed the party on 16% here in the Greens' target region of East England. Because the European Elections use a fair-voting system, this swell of popular support should be enough to secure a Green victory on June 4th in the Euro elections and get Rupert Read elected - *if* everybody turns out to vote. In a YouGov poll the Greens have emerged as the party said to be the least likely to engage in any unethical behaviour, beating UKIP by 3 times, and Labour by a factor of 9.
